

## 2010 Pottawatomie Ladies League

The Pottawatomie Ladies League will be starting soon, and we hope you are planning to join this year!

We'll meet **Wednesday, April 21<sup>st</sup>, at 7:00 p.m. in the Pottawatomie Community Center** for the general information meeting. Jim Wheeler, our golf pro, will be there to field any questions you might have about the golf course, rules, or golf etiquette. Early registration will be available. Our first day of league play will be Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, with tee times beginning at 6:00 a.m. You may call the Pro Shop at **630-584-8356** to schedule your tee time starting May 26th, at 6:00 a.m. (You may sign up for one foursome only). Dues will be **\$34** for the season, and covers the cost of computing your handicap each week, year-end awards, weekly prizes, and other league expenses. League play will run 12 weeks. For St. Charles Park District residents, the greens fee per week will be \$16.00 (\$13.00 for resident Seniors), and the rates for non-residents are \$18.00 (\$15.00 for non-resident Seniors). Weekly fees are paid only on the Tuesdays you participate in league play. If you are new to the league, please make every attempt to play five 9-hole rounds prior to June 2nd. You must have a handicap to qualify for our fun weekly events and prizes.

I hope you will each volunteer an hour of your time again for the starter's table. You can "guarantee" your tee time, and it's a great way to meet your fellow league players! Please sign up for one week or for the season on registration night or at the clubhouse.

We have so many great events planned this year including [\*Pink Ribbon/Rally for a Cure Day on June 22<sup>nd</sup>\*](#) to benefit the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation. An additional donation of \$20.00 to the Komen Foundation is requested to participate, and each of you will receive a pink ribbon golf pin, and goodie bag.
